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PUBLIC HEARING MEETING MINUTES

August 23, 2021 @ 6:30 p.m.

A Public Hearing Meeting of the Planning Commission of Castle Rock Township was held on Monday, August 23, 2021. Those participating were Jim Heiman, Braden Schuenke, Norbert Kuhn, Ken Betzold, Maxim Litvinov and Molly Weber. Others in attendance were Jon Juenke and resident Armin Kilbe.

Jim Heiman called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

1. The purpose of the hearing is to consider, hear from the public, and act to make a recommendation to the Township Board regarding a request for a zoning ordinance variance to build an AG shed on PID# 07-00200-01-019 owned by Jon Juenke. All persons desiring to be heard in person or in writing will be heard at this time.

Jim Heiman read through the agenda.

Jon Juenke explained his request for his grain set up. Jon stated he is requesting a Variance since per the Ordinance he should be 130' from the centerline and in this case the AG building would be 108' from the centerline. Jon would like to build a 27' x 18' x 14' shed to cover the cement pad that is already there. There was no permit needed at the time of the pit (pad) being put in so a Variance is needed in this case since the rules have changed. It will mainly be used in the fall to keep his crops out of the elements.

Neighbor Armin Kilbe wanted to make sure this was not going to be a hog pen.

Norbert Kuhn made a motion to recommend that the Board of Supervisors approve the Variance for road frontage setback at PID#07-00200-01-019. Ken Betzold seconded. Motion carried.
